 3. In every age, and ever, let us praise his name,
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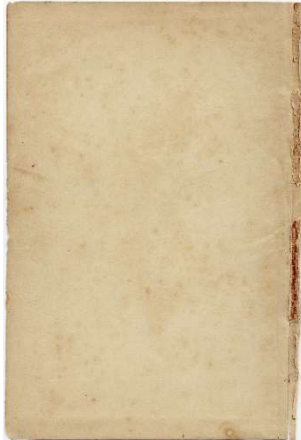
Joy (joɪ), *n.*, a celebration of a special occasion, especially one that is joyful.

Jubilee (dʒuːˈbiːliː), *n.*, a Jewish festival or anniversary.



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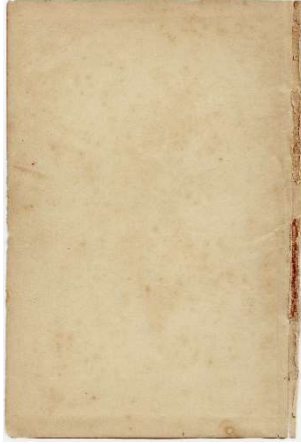
